All classes completed at DMACC require a C or higher in order to transfer to Mercy.

*Both BIO 168 and BIO 173 must be completed with a C or better at DMACC in order to transfer in as BIO 180 and BIO 185.

**If CHM 101 only is taken, it can count towards the 100 level chemistry at Mercy College but both CHM 101 and CHM 102 or needed for a Chemistry minor.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is my (a) CNA class or certification required to be admitted to Mercy's BSN program?	No. Your (neither) CNA is not required, but would be a great way to prepare for nursing classes.
Does Mercy College have a waitlist?	No. The traditional BSN program does not have a waitlist.
How long does the BSN take?	Students typically graduate in 7 or 8 semesters (2-3 years) depending on how many courses transfer in.
What other classes would help me prepare for the BSN?	Although not required, basic and advanced CNA classes will help prepare you for nursing classes at Mercy. It is also a good idea to get your CPR certification.
Should I complete my AA or AS prior to transferring?	It is not recommended to complete your AA or AS before transferring. It is possible to take classes at both institutions and earn your BSN in as little as two and a half years. A specialized plan can be made for you by your Mercy Academic Advisor to ensure you are taking the right classes.
Are any nursing entrance exams such as the HESI or the TEAS required for admission?	No. Mercy College does not require entrance exams.

Are any prerequisites required?	No prerequisites are required for admission into the program. You can also start nursing classes in your first term.
When should I apply?	(There are no application deadlines, but we recommend applying six months before your intended start date. We have fall, spring, and summer start dates.
